FIELD NOTES: The beans at this location were the hardest cutting beans that I have had all year. Most still had green stems and all their dead leaves. Rainfall during Aug. was limited and Sept. temps were cooler than normal in this area. Plant heights ranged from 30-48" tall. Plot average was close to the field average around it.
