TEST COMMENTS: Planted in twin rows spaced 8" apart on 30" centers. George applied Mustang for aphid control. Harvested plant heights were 36"-45". Harvested seed was large & very good quality. Excessive amounts of rain during the growing season stunted the growth of some varieties. Lat: N39.16958, Long: W88.27341
