TEST COMMENTS: Dry weather during planting through July encourage root growth. Timely rains in August helped fill pods. Gary sprayed Brigade on August 3rd to control aphid hot spots. Control was good. Gary thought his beans would be equal to his 5-year average of 42 bpa, but yields have been better than that. Plant height was about 36". Lat: N44.9258, Long: W95.77234
